A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to authorize the
- 2 respective county councils to enact more stringent fireworks
- 3 laws than those imposed by state fireworks law under chapter
- 4 132D, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 132D-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 "\$132D-17 Inconsistent county ordinances, rules.
- 8 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, no county shall
- 9 enact ordinances or adopt any rules regulating fireworks or
- 10 articles pyrotechnic, except as required in this chapter, that
- 11 is inconsistent with or [more] less restrictive than, the
- 12 provisions of this chapter. Any ordinances and rules regulating
- 13 fireworks or articles pyrotechnic that were enacted or adopted
- 14 by a county before March 31, 1995, except those provisions
- 15 $[\frac{\text{which}}{\text{r}}]$ that are not inconsistent with $[\frac{1}{7}]$ or $[\frac{\text{more}}{\text{r}}]$ less
- 16 restrictive than those of this chapter, are declared void."

- 1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
