The director shall have professional training in the field of social work, education, public health, and other 10 11 related fields; extensive direct experience in programs or 12 services related to elders; and recent experience in a supervisory, consultative, or administrative position. 13 The 14 director shall be nominated and appointed by the governor 15 without regard to chapters 76 and 89. Effective July 1, [2005,] 2008, the director shall be paid a salary set by the appointing 16 authority that shall not exceed [sixty nine] eighty per cent of 17

1 the salary of the director of human resources development. The 2 director shall be included in any benefit program generally 3 applicable to the officers and employees of the State." 4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008. 7
