A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TAX CREDITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of business, economic
- 2 development, and tourism shall conduct a comprehensive study to
- 3 determine the social and economic benefits, if any, derived from
- 4 state tax credits provided by the legislature; provided that the
- 5 department may contract for a private entity to carry out the
- 6 study.
- 7 (b) The department of business, economic development, and
- 8 tourism shall submit a report containing the results of the
- 9 study to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the
- 10 convening of the regular session of 2009.
- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for a
- 14 comprehensive study to determine the social and economic
- 15 benefits of state tax credits provided by the legislature.
- 16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 17 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of
- 18 this Act.
