A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE KALOKO HOUSING PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that next to Oahu, the
- 2 county of Hawaii has the largest number of homeless individuals,
- 3 individuals at-risk of becoming homeless, and hidden homeless.
- 4 West Hawaii is particularly in need of more housing and support
- 5 services for the homeless because its only homeless shelter
- 6 needs to be replaced. There is a proposal to build a 50
- 7 multifamily cluster of homes to provide housing for the homeless
- 8 and related support services.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the
- 10 design, planning, and construction of the Kaloko housing program
- 11 in West Hawaii to help families affected by homelessness.
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$12,000,000 or so
- 14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for
- 15 the design, planning, and construction of the Kaloko housing
- 16 program in West Hawaii.
- 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the county of
- 18 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
