
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The Hawaii public housing authority shall
2 conduct a study on creating incentives to allow public housing
3 tenants or individuals receiving housing subsidies to transition
4 to permanent housing and reduce dependency on public housing and
5 rent supplement assistance.

6 (b) The study shall include but not be limited to the
7 following:

- 8 (1) Using a portion of section 8 or other rental
9 assistance subsidies to transition to homeownership;
- 10 (2) Creating a homeownership savings program for
11 individuals in public housing by setting aside a
12 portion of the monthly rental payments; and
- 13 (3) Developing further, the individual development account
14 program established under chapter 257, Hawaii Revised
15 Statutes, to assist with first-time homeownership.
- 16 (c) The Hawaii public housing authority shall submit a
17 report to the legislature of its findings and recommendations,

1 including any proposed legislation, no later than twenty days
2 prior to the regular session of 2009.

3 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
