BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 356D-20, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[+]\$356D-20[+] Duty to make reports. Except as otherwise provided by law, the authority shall be responsible for the 4 5 following reports: 6 (1)The authority shall file at least once a year with the 7 governor a report of its activities for the preceding 8 fiscal year; 9 The authority shall report to the comptroller on (2)10 moneys deposited in depositories other than the state treasury under section 40-81, and rules adopted 11 12 thereunder; and 13 (3) The authority shall submit an annual report to the 14 legislature on all program areas no later than twenty days prior to the convening of each regular session, 15 16 that shall provide the following information on the 17 status of its programs and finances:

1	(A)	A financial audit and report conducted on an
2		annual basis by a certified public accounting
3		firm; [and]
4	(B)	The number of vacant units in public housing
5		projects, how long each unit was vacant, reasons
6		for each vacancy, methods used to place an
7		individual or family in each vacant unit
8		including the process for repairing the unit, if
9		applicable, and how the authority is working with
10		the community to address vacancies; and
11	[(B)] <u>(C)</u>	Recommendations with reference to any additional
12	×	legislation or other action that may be necessary
13		to carry out the purposes of this chapter."
