A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DAM SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 179D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and 2 to read as follows: 3 . LIMITATIONS ON LIABILITY 4 "PART §179D-A Liability of stockholders, directors, and 5 officers. Stockholders, directors, and officers of any 6 corporation that owns, operates, or controls a dam or reservoir 7 8 in this state shall have the same measure of immunity from 9 liability for corporate acts or omissions as stockholders, directors, and officers under chapter 414 or 414D, as 10 11 appropriate. 12 §179D-B Liability for personal injury or property damage. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, no entity or 13 14 person that owns, controls, or operates a dam or reservoir shall
- 16 (1) Resulting from water escaping from the dam or 17 reservoir, including the transmission system or

be liable for any personal injury or property damage:

irrigation system associated with the dam or 1 reservoir, by overflow; or 2 Resulting from a failure or partial failure of the 3 (2) structure or structures forming that dam or reservoir, 4 including the transmission system or irrigation system 5 associated with the dam or reservoir; provided that 6 the failure or partial failure was not proximately 7 caused by the negligence of the entity or person. 8 No entity or person shall be subject to punitive or exemplary 9 damages for negligence, as provided in this section, in excess 10 11 of that provided by law. (b) No entity or person that owns, controls, or operates a 12 dam or reservoir shall be liable for any personal injury or 13 property damage that results from allowing the inflow to the dam 14 or reservoir, including the transmission system or irrigation 15 system associated with the dam or reservoir, to pass through it 16 and into a natural stream below the reservoir. 17 In the event of any conflict between this part and any 18 other law or judicial interpretation, this part shall control. 19 \$179D-C Insurance. (a) No stockholder, officer, or 20 member of a board of directors of an owner of a dam or reservoir 21

18	of any one	e incident. The policy may provide that it does not
19	apply to a	any act or omission of a stockholder, officer, or

member of a board of directors of an owner if the act or

omission is dishonest, fraudulent, malicious, or criminal.

- to policy periods, territory, claims, conditions, and othermatters common to those policies of insurance.
 - (c) An adequate substitute for insurance pursuant to subsection (a) is limited to any one or more of the following:
- 5 (1) A bond in an amount equal to the coverage limitations set forth in subsection (b) and duly issued by a 6 qualified corporate surety approved by the insurance 7 commissioner; provided that the bond is conditioned 8 9 upon the payment by the entity or person that owns, controls, or operates a dam or reservoir of any valid 10 final judgment for damages imposed pursuant to this 11 12 part;
 - irrevocable letter or annual letters of credit issued by any national or state bank and deposited with an escrow agent pursuant to an escrow contract or agreement requiring the escrow agent to pay from the escrow account amounts necessary to discharge a final judgment for damages within the coverage limitations set forth in subsection (b); provided that the escrow contract or agreement cannot be revoked or amended until after any claims for damages against the entity

1	or person have been discharged or until applicable		
2	statutes of limitations have expired; or		
3	(3) A combination of insurance and any of the substitutes		
4	described in this section, so long as the aggregate		
5	value satisfies the coverage limitations set forth in		
6	subsection (b).		
7	(d) The provisions of this section shall not be deemed to		
8	impose any liability upon a member of the board of directors, as		
9	officer, or a stockholder of the owner of a dam or reservoir		
10	greater than that provided in section 179D-A.		
11	§179D-D Exempt acts or omissions. The limitations on		
12	liability set forth in this part shall not apply to:		
13	(1) Criminal, fraudulent, or malicious acts or omissions;

15	(2) Ultra vires acts or omissions,		
16	by an owner or a member of the board of directors, officer, or		
17	stockholder of an owner."		
18	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties tha		
19	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were		
20	begun, before its effective date.		
21	SECTION 3. In codifying the new sections added by section		
22	1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
