# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DAM SAFETY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 179D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and 2 to read as follows: 3 . LIMITATIONS ON LIABILITY 4 5 §179D-A Liability of stockholders, directors, and officers. Stockholders, directors, and officers of any 6 corporation that is an owner or operator of a dam or reservoir 7 in this state shall have the same measure of immunity from 8 9 liability for corporate acts or omissions as stockholders, directors, and officers under chapter 414 or 414D, as 10 11 appropriate. §179D-B Liability for personal injury or property damage. 12 13 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, no entity or person that is an owner or operator of a dam or reservoir shall 14 be liable for any personal injury or property damage: 15

Resulting from water escaping from the dam or

reservoir, including the transmission system or

1	irrigation system associated with the dam of
2	reservoir, by overflow; or
3	(2) Resulting from a failure or partial failure of the
4	structure or structures forming that dam or reservoir,
5	including the transmission system or irrigation system
6	associated with the dam or reservoir;
7	provided that the escaped water or the failure or partial
8	failure of the structure was not proximately caused by the
9	negligence of the owner or operator. No entity or person shall
10	be subject to punitive or exemplary damages for negligence, as
11	provided in this section, in excess of that provided by law.
12	(b) No entity or person that is an owner or operator of a
13	dam or reservoir shall be liable for any personal injury or
14	property damage that results from allowing the inflow to the dam
15	or reservoir, including the transmission system or irrigation
16	system associated with the dam or reservoir, to pass through it
17	and into a natural stream below the reservoir; provided that the
18	injury or damage was not proximately caused by the negligence of
19	the owner or operator.
20	(c) In the event of any conflict between this part and any
21	other law or judicial interpretation, this part shall control.

\$179D-C Insurance. (a) No stockholder, officer, or 1 member of a board of directors of an owner or operator of a dam 2 or reservoir shall be liable for any personal injury or property 3 4 damages: Resulting from water escaping from the dam or 5 (1)reservoir, including the transmission system or 6 irrigation system associated with the dam or 7 8 reservoir; or 9 (2) Resulting from a failure or partial failure of the 10 structure or structures forming the dam or reservoir, including the transmission system or irrigation system 11 associated with the dam or reservoir, 12 13 for which the owner or operator has been found liable by a court of competent jurisdiction if the owner or operator is insured by 14 a valid liability insurance policy meeting the requirements set 15 forth in subsection (b) and in effect at the time the damage 16 17 occurs or has an adequate substitute under subsection (c) at the time the damage occurs. 18 (b) An insurance policy meeting the qualifications of 19 subsection (a) shall insure against damages and provide coverage 20 in an amount of not less than \$ per claim and an aggregate 21 amount of not less than \$ for all claims that arise out of 22 HB2823 HD2 HMS 2008-2127

- (c) An adequate substitute for insurance pursuant to 8 subsection (a) is limited to any one or more of the following: 9
- (1) A bond in an amount equal to the coverage limitations 10 set forth in subsection (b) and duly issued by a 11 qualified corporate surety approved by the insurance 12 commissioner; provided that the bond is conditioned 13 upon the payment by the entity or person that owns, 14 15 controls, or operates a dam or reservoir of any valid final judgment for damages imposed pursuant to this 16

- 18 (2) An escrow of acceptable securities or an annual irrevocable letter or annual letters of credit issued 19 by any national or state bank and deposited with an 20 21 escrow agent pursuant to an escrow contract or 22

agreement requiring the escrow agent to pay from the

1		escrow account amounts necessary to discharge a final
2		judgment for damages within the coverage limitations
3		set forth in subsection (b); provided that the escrow
4		contract or agreement cannot be revoked or amended
5		until after any claims for damages against the entity
6		or person have been discharged or until applicable
7		statutes of limitations have expired; or
8	(3)	A combination of insurance and any of the substitutes
9		described in this section, so long as the aggregate
10		value satisfies the coverage limitations set forth in
11		subsection (b).
12	(d)	The provisions of this section shall not be deemed to
13	impose an	y liability upon a member of the board of directors, an
14	officer,	or a stockholder of the owner or operator of a dam or
15	reservoir	greater than that provided in section 179D-A.
16	§179	D-D Exempt acts or omissions. The limitations on
17	liability	set forth in this part shall not apply to:
18	(1)	Criminal, fraudulent, or malicious acts or omissions;
19		gross negligence; intentional, willful, or wanton
20		acts; or conduct in reckless disregard of public
