BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 707-730, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (2) to read as follows:
3	"(2) Sexual assault in the first degree is a class A
4	felony[-]; provided that the court may require a person who is
5	convicted under subsection (1)(a) or who has a prior conviction
6	under this section to wear, for up to ten years after the
7	person's release from imprisonment, a global positioning system
8	transmitter that transmits the person's location to the Hawaii
9	paroling authority, the department of public safety, or any
10	county police department."
11	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
12	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
13	begun, before its effective date.
14	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
16	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
