A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAII GREEN SEAL PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. The department of business, economic
2	developme	nt, and tourism shall develop and implement a Hawaii
3	green seal program to certify businesses and organizations in	
4	the State that derive at least twenty per cent of their energy	
5	usage from renewable sources, such as solar, wind, wave,	
6	geothermal, or biofuel energy sources.	
7	SECTION 2. There is established within the department of	
8	business, economic development, and tourism for administrative	
9	purposes an advisory task force to provide input on the	
10	developme	nt of the Hawaii green seal program. The task force
11	shall include:	
12	(1)	Three members to be appointed by the president of the
13		senate;
14	(2)	Three members to be appointed by the speaker of the
15		house of representatives;
16	(3)	The director of business, economic development, and
17		tourism or the director's designee;

- (4) Thé director of commerce and consumer affairs or the
 director's designee; and
- 3 (5) The director of labor and industrial relations or the4 director's designee.
- 5 The director of business, economic development, and tourism
- 6 or the director's designee shall serve as the chairperson of the
- 7 task force.
- 8 (b) The task force shall have the following duties:
- 9 (1) Design the Hawaii green seal;
- (2) Establish qualifying criteria for receiving the Hawaiigreen seal;
- (3) Establish guidelines for maintaining the Hawaii greenseal certification; and
- (4) Conduct periodic reviews of Hawaii green sealcriteria.
- 16 SECTION 3. The task force shall submit a report on its
- 17 findings and recommendations, including any necessary proposed
- 18 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 19 to the convening of the regular session of 2009.
- 20 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 21 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 22 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 to develop

- 1 the Hawaii green seal program, including necessary travel
- 2 expenses for the members of the task force.
- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 4 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of
