BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 52D-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+] \$52D-3[+] Powers and duties of chief of police. (a)
- 4 The chief of police shall have the powers and duties as
- 5 prescribed by law, the respective county charter, and as
- 6 provided by this chapter.
- 7 (b) The chief of police shall have the power to enter
- 8 without warrant the common areas of any public housing project,
- 9 as defined in section 356D-1 or 356D-91, for the purpose of
- 10 enforcing applicable state and county laws thereon. For
- 11 purposes of this subsection, "common area" means real property
- 12 within a public housing project, including community facilities
- 13 as defined in section 356D-1, and excludes dwelling units as
- 14 defined in section 356D-1."
- 15 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
