## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE BUILDING CODE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 107-28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+]§107-28[+] County building code authority to amend the
- 4 state model building code without state approval. (a) The
- 5 governing body of each county shall amend the state building
- 6 code as it applies within its respective jurisdiction, in
- 7 accordance with section 46-1.5(13), without approval of the
- 8 council[ $\div$ ]; provided that no amendment shall reduce the number
- 9 of public toilet facilities available for use by employees,
- 10 customers, patrons, and visitors in structures and tenant spaces
- 11 intended for public utilization below the number required by the
- 12 Uniform Plumbing Code. Each county shall use the model codes
- 13 and standards listed in section 107-25, as the referenced model
- 14 building codes and standards for its respective county building
- 15 code ordinance, no later than two years after the adoption of
- 16 the state building code.
- 17 (b) If a county does not amend the statewide model code
- 18 within the two-year timeframe, the state building code shall

- 1 become applicable as an interim county building code until the
- 2 county adopts the amendments."
- 3 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed.
- 4 New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon approval.
