A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE THIRTY-EIGHTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Mililani high school's stadium is the venue for
- 2 many of the Oahu interscholastic association sporting events.
- 3 Because the field is grass, it requires a great deal of
- 4 maintenance. However, none of the other schools using the field
- 5 are required to share in the maintenance and the responsibility,
- 6 which means that the cost of maintenance falls to Mililani high
- 7 school. Installation of synthetic turf would be easier and less
- 8 costly to maintain and ensure that the field would be in the
- 9 best condition possible for interscholastic sporting events.
- 10 Mililani middle school serves all middle school age
- 11 children in Mililani. Because there is very heavy rainfall in
- 12 the Mililani mauka area where the school is located, there is a
- 13 need to provide covered bus stops for the health and safety of
- 14 students.
- 15 The purpose of this Act is to provide funding for capital
- 16 improvement projects in the thirty-eight representative
- 17 district.
