## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOUSING.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that home prices in 2 Hawaii, due to a variety of cost factors, have risen to a level 3 beyond the reach of many Hawaii families. 4 The purpose of this Act is to require the Hawaii housing finance and development corporation to report to the legislature 5 with a list of cost items that impact the cost of homes in the 6 7 State. SECTION 2. The Hawaii housing finance and development 8 9 corporation, in conjunction with appropriate state and county agencies and with the assistance of appropriate private sector 10 businesses, shall develop a list of cost items that impact the 11 cost of homes in the State, particularly those encountered by 12 13 the Hawaii housing finance and development corporation. list shall not include land or construction costs but shall 14 examine the costs prior to construction, such as time delays for 15

Costs during construction other than material and labor costs directly attributed to the cost of construction shall

permit approval and impact fees levied against home developers.
