## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Hawaii health commission; establishment. (a)
- 2 There is established within the department of budget and finance
- 3 for administrative purposes the Hawaii health commission. The
- 4 commission shall be an autonomous public body corporate and
- 5 politic and an instrumentality of the State.
- 6 (b) The commission shall be composed of nine members
- 7 appointed by the governor as provided in section 26-34; provided
- 8 that three members shall be appointed from a list of nominees
- 9 submitted by the speaker of the house of representatives and
- 10 three members shall be appointed from a list of nominees
- 11 submitted by the president of the senate. All members shall be
- 12 appointed for terms of four years each.
- 13 (c) An executive director shall be selected by a majority
- 14 vote of the members.
- 15 (d) Each member shall hold office until the member's
- 16 successor is appointed and qualified.

(e) Five members shall constitute a quorum, whose 1 2 affirmative vote shall be necessary for all valid actions by the 3 commission. SECTION 2. Duties and responsibilities. 4 (a) The commission shall be responsible for overall health planning for 5 the State and shall be responsible for determining future 6 7 capacity needs of health providers, facilities, equipment, and 8 support services providers. The commission shall develop a comprehensive health 9 10 plan that includes: 11 (1)Determination of eligibility for inclusion in a health plan for all individuals in the state; 12 13 (2) Determination of all reimbursable services to be paid by the commission; 14 15 (3) Determination of all approved providers of services in 16 a health plan for all individuals in the state; 17 Evaluation of the quality and cost-effectiveness of (4)18 all aspects of a health plan for all individuals; and 19 (5) Establishment of a budget for a health plan for all 20 individuals in the state. 21 The commission shall submit to the legislature, no 22 later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular



- 1 session of 2010, a comprehensive health plan for all individuals
- 2 in the state, including the commission's findings and
- 3 recommendations.
- 4 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- $\mathbf{6}$  much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for
- 7 the operations of the Hawaii health commission.
- 8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 9 budget and finance for the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 11 provided that section 3 shall take effect on July 1, 2008;
- 12 provided further that sections 1 and 2 shall be repealed when
- 13 the Hawaii health commission has submitted the comprehensive
- 14 health plan, and its findings and recommendations pursuant to
- 15 section 2(c) of this Act.
