A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR FERAL PIG ABATEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general 1 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much 2 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for the 3 reduction and abatement of the feral pig population, including 4 the purchase and maintenance of tools and equipment necessary 5 for abatement activities, such as box traps, baits, and corrals. 6 The sum expended shall be expended by the department of 7 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act. 8 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008. 9 10
