## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VETERANS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Veterans
2	Administration (VA) Pacific Islands Health Care System serves
3	veterans in the Pacific Basin, a geographic service area of 4.8
4	million square miles, providing diagnostic, medical, mental
5	health, and specialty care outpatient treatment. Care is
6	provided from its main clinic on Oahu and through five
7	community-based outpatient clinics in the Hawaiian islands and
8	Guam. Additionally, at a 16-bed post-traumatic stress disorder
9	(PTSD) residential rehabilitation center on Oahu, veterans
10	receive unique PTSD treatment and education. VA also operates a
11	60-bed Center for Aging (nursing home) in Honolulu. Currently,
12	hospitalization is provided through a sharing agreement with
13	Tripler Army Medical Center and community hospitals.
14	Many veterans reside on the island of Maui, making it
15	difficult to travel to Oahu for treatment and other services.
16	The purpose of this Act is to authorize the issuance of
17	general obligation bonds for the construction of a state
18	veterans hospital on the island of Maui, provided that no funds

- 3 SECTION 2. The following sums or so much thereof as shall
- 4 be sufficient to finance the project listed in this Act are
- 5 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
- 6 Hawaii for fiscal year 2007-2008:
- 7 A. Hawaii health systems foundation, Maui
- 8 Plans, land aquisition, design, construction, and
- 9 equipment for a veterans hospital in Maui county.
- 10 Plans \$1,000
- 11 Land \$1,000
- 12 Design \$1,000
- 13 Construction \$19,996,000
- 14 Equipment \$1,000
- 15 Total funding \$20,000,000
- 16 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
- 17 health systems corporation for the purposes of this Act;
- 18 provided that no funds shall be made available under this Act
- 19 unless federal matching funds for this purpose are first made
- 20 available.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
