A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NOISE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 663, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§663- Noise; private nuisance; relief. (a) A person
5	who alleges the existence of a private nuisance due to excessive
6	noise may bring a civil action for appropriate injunctive
7	relief, or actual damages, or both within two years after the
8	occurrence of the alleged violation of this part.
9	(b) An action commenced pursuant to subsection (a) may be
10	brought in the circuit court for the circuit where the alleged
11	violation occurred, where the complainant resides, or where the
12	person against whom the civil complaint is filed resides or has
13	a principal place of business.
14	(c) For purposes of this section:
15	(1) "Damages" means damages for injury or loss caused by
16	excessive noise or vibration, including reasonable
17	attorney fees;

1	(2)	"Excessive noise" means the presence of sound of a	
2		volume or in quantities and for durations that	
3		unreasonably interferes with the comfortable enjoyment	
4		of life and property; and	
5	(3)	"Nuisance" means any interference with reasonable use	
6		and enjoyment of property and includes all claims that	
7		meet the requirements of this definition regardless of	
8		whether a complainant designates the claims as brought	
9		in nuisance, negligence, trespass, or any other claim	
10		under law or equity.	
11	(d)	It shall not be a prerequisite for institution of an	
12	action un	der this section that the nuisance alleged has been	
13	determine	d to involve excessive noise pursuant to chapter 342F.	
14	It shall be evidence that the alleged nuisance under this		
15	section has been determined to involve excessive noise pursuant		
16	to chapter 342F. Nothing in this section shall in any way		
17	restrict or impede the authority of the State to protect the		
18	public health, safety, and welfare."		
19	SECTION 2. Section 342F-12, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
20	amended to read as follows:		
21	"§34	2F-12 Injunctive and other relief. (a) The director	
22	may insti	tute a civil action in any court of competent

- 1 jurisdiction for injunctive and other relief to prevent any
- 2 violation of this chapter, any rule adopted pursuant to this
- 3 chapter, or any condition of a permit or variance issued
- 4 pursuant to this chapter, without the necessity of a prior
- 5 revocation of the permit or variance, to impose and collect
- 6 civil penalties, to collect administrative penalties, or to
- 7 obtain other relief. The court shall have power to grant relief
- 8 in accordance with the Hawaii rules of civil procedure.
- 9 (b) Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to preclude
- 10 a private action pursuant to section 663- ."
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 12 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 13 begun, before its effective date.
- 14 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
