A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that traffic congestion 2 in the State is increasing. Traffic congestion contributes to diminished safety and air quality and imposes substantial costs 3 on residents and businesses. The availability of lane miles for 4 commuters is a factor in traffic flow. Hawaii is lane deficient 5 when compared to states with similar population densities. 6 department of transportation currently provides, operates, and 7 8 maintains 2,423 lane miles of highway at a low level of service. 9 Traffic flow approaching a point often exceeds the amount of 10 traffic that can be served. As a result, commuters experience 11 stop-and-go waves, poor travel time, low comfort and 12 convenience, and increased accident exposure. 13 The department of transportation highways division has

The department of transportation highways division has abandoned the suggestion of building more highways in favor of other alternatives. However, it is possible that rights-of-way may exist that could provide a plausible means of expanding lane miles. The legislature further finds that the department of
