A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILD PROTECTIVE SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 587-88, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[§587-88] Child protective review panel. 4 department shall establish a child protective review panel to 5 review each case of serious abuse. Upon the request of the 6 child's family, the panel also shall review child protective proceedings taken prior to or without a court order, where the 7 8 child's family believes that the child was wrongfully removed 9 from the family home. Based upon its review, the panel shall 10 submit a report of findings and recommendations to the director. The department shall appoint members of the child protective 11 12 review panel who may include, but not be limited to: 13 (1)Any physician treating the child for abuse; 14 Any child protective services worker assigned to the (2) 15 case and the worker's supervisor; The guardian ad litem for the child, appointed under 16 (3) section 587-34, if applicable; 17

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1	(4)	The members of the child's multidisciplinary team or
2		child protective services consultant; [and]
3	(5)	An individual who represents the interests of the
4		family; and
5	[(5)]	(6) Other child protective services workers and
6		supervisors.
7	(b)	Members of the child protective review panel shall
8	serve wit	hout compensation and shall not be reimbursed for
9	costs, ex	cept for state employees serving within the scope of
10	their emp	loyment who shall receive compensation and
11	reimburse	ments as provided by law or by collective bargaining.
12	(c)	Members of the child protective review panel shall be
13	immune fr	om any liability for injuries and damages arising from
14	the panel	's report under subsection (a).
15	(d)	This section shall not be construed as interfering
16	with any	authority of the department or the courts to remove, to
17	place, or	to order any disposition on custody of the abused
18	child und	er this chapter; provided that any decision related to
19	a review	initiated by a child's family under this section shall
20	be made a	vailable to the court in subsequent child protective
21	services	proceedings.

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1	(e) As used in this section, "serious abuse" means
2	reabuse, hospitalization, or death arising from an abuse."
