A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 171, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 Powers; non-delegation. Notwithstanding section "§171-5 171-6(8), the board shall not delegate to the chairperson powers 6 and duties that relate: 7 (1) To the bureau of conveyances; 8 (2) To the conservation and resources enforcement program under chapter 199; and 10 (3) Primarily to natural resources." 11 SECTION 2. Section 6E-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 12 amended to read as follows: 13 "[+]§6E-5[+] State historic preservation officer. 14 governor shall appoint a state historic preservation officer, 15 and may appoint the officer without regard to chapter 76, who 16 shall be responsible for the comprehensive historic preservation 17 program and who shall be the state liaison officer for the

- 2 preservation. The state historic preservation officer shall be
- 3 appointed on the basis of professional competence and experience

- 6 In appointing the state historic preservation officer, the
- 7 governor shall select from a list of four candidates. Two
- 8 candidates shall be selected by the speaker of the house of

- 11 SECTION 3. Section 6K-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

1 The board shall consist of seven members, one from each 2 land district and three at large. The appointment, tenure, and 3 removal of the members and the filling of vacancies on the board 4 shall be as provided in section 26-34. [At least one member] 5 All members of the board shall have a background in conservation 6 and natural resources, as provided in section 171-4. 7 The governor shall appoint the chairperson of the board from among the members thereof. 8 The board may delegate to the chairperson such duties, 9 10 powers, and authority, or so much thereof, as may be lawful or proper for the performance of the functions vested in the 11 board[-], except as otherwise provided in section 171- . 12 13 The chairperson of the board shall serve in a full-time 14 capacity. The chairperson, in that capacity, shall perform those duties, and exercise those powers and authority, or so 15 16 much thereof, as may be delegated by the board [-], except as otherwise provided in section 171- ." 17 18 SECTION 5. Section 171-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 19 The board of land and natural resources shall be 20 composed of seven members, one from each land district and three 21 at large, to be nominated and, by and with the advice and 22
