## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENHANCED PENALTIES FOR INSURANCE VIOLATIONS COMMITTED AGAINST ELDERS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding two new sections to article 2 to be
- 3 appropriately designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§431:2- Additional administrative penalties for
- 5 insurance violations committed against elders. If a person
- 6 commits a violation under this chapter and the violation is
- 7 directed toward, targets, or is committed against a person who
- 8 at the time of the violation is sixty-years-of-age or older, the
- 9 commissioner, in addition to any other administrative penalty,
- 10 may impose an administrative penalty not to exceed \$50,000 for
- 11 each violation.
- 12 §431:2- Additional civil penalties for insurance
- 13 violations committed against elders. If a person commits a
- 14 violation under this chapter and the violation is directed
- 15 toward, targets, or is committed against a person who at the
- 16 time of the violation is sixty-years-of-age or older, a court,

- 1 in addition to any other civil penalty, may impose a civil
- penalty not to exceed \$50,000 for each violation."
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun, before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
