A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WELL CHILD FOLLOW-UP VISITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish a well
- 2 child follow-up visit pilot project to determine if providing a
- 3 face-to-face visit with the child and family within a year after
- 4 a case has been investigated and closed because the allegation
- 5 of abuse or neglect was not confirmed, will decrease the
- 6 possibility of additional reports of substantial abuse or
- 7 neglect involving the same child and family.
- 8 SECTION 2. (a) There is established a well child follow-
- 9 up visit pilot project within the department of human services
- 10 to provide for a well child visit with families who have been
- 11 reported to and investigated by child welfare services, but who
- 12 have not been confirmed for child abuse or neglect, pursuant to
- 13 section 587-21, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to ensure the continued
- 14 safety and well-being of the child.
- 15 (b) The well child follow-up visit pilot project may
- 16 include conducting a well child follow-up visit for each child
- 17 in cases where physical or sexual abuse or neglect has been

- 1 alleged and investigated but not confirmed after completion of
- 2 the investigation.
- 3 (c) The well child follow-up visit may be conducted no
- 4 earlier than six months, but within one year, after the
- 5 completion of the investigation.
- 6 (d) The department of human services or its designated
- 7 contractor shall provide well child follow-up visits. The
- 8 department may contract with an appropriate entity to provide
- 9 these services.
- (e) The pilot project shall cease to exist on June 30,
- 11 2009. The department of human services shall submit a report on
- 12 the findings and recommendations of the project to the
- 13 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 14 the 2010 regular session.
- 15 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,000,000 or so much
- 17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for the
- 18 well child follow-up visit pilot project.
- 19 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 20 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
