A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE LABOR AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS APPEALS BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to authorize the
- 2 labor and industrial relations appeals board to employ a
- 3 hearings officer. Enabling language regarding a hearings
- 4 officer in this Act would allow the board to expedite hearings
- 5 on issues concerning workers' compensation treatment plans,
- 6 vocational rehabilitation, and temporary total disability. The
- 7 hearings officer would hear these issues and propose a decision
- 8 and order for review and approval by the full board. This would
- 9 afford expedited resolution of time-sensitive matters appealed
- 10 from decisions of the director of labor and industrial relations
- 11 to the board.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 371-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by amending subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 14 "(f) The chairperson of the appeal board shall be
- 15 responsible for the administrative functions of the appeal
- 16 board. The appeal board may:
