A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the scope and level 2 of responsibility of the board of education, as the state 3 education agency with statewide policymaking authority and 4 oversight over the public schools and public libraries, have 5 grown significantly. 6 The legislature further finds that board of education 7 members are not salaried, but receive compensation at a rate of 8 \$100 per day for each day's actual attendance at meetings. 9 compensation rate for board of education members was statutorily 10 established in 1966 at a rate of \$50 per day, and was 11 subsequently increased to \$100 per day in 1989. Compensation 12 for board members has not increased since then. 13 The purpose of this Act is to increase the compensation of the members of the board of education, establish a protocol 14

15 allowance for board members, and allow board members to receive 16 personal expenses, at rates specified by the board, while 17 attending board meetings or while on official business as 18 authorized by the board chairperson.
