BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

- 4 SECTION 2. The department of human services shall submit a
- 5 request to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to
