4	inspection. [Whoever operates, permits] (a) No person shall					
5	operate, permit the operation of, [causes] cause to be operated,					
6	or [parks] <u>park</u> any vehicle on a public highway without a					
7	current official certificate of inspection, issued under section					
8	286-26[, shall be fined not more than \$100].					
9	(b) Any person who violates this section shall be subject					
10	to:					
11	(1) A fine of not less than \$500 and not more than \$1,000					
12	for the first violation;					
13	(2) A fine of not less than \$750 and not more than \$1,000					
14	for the second violation; and					
15	(3) A fine of not less than \$1,000 and suspension of					
16	license and privileges to operate a vehicle for a					
17	period of thirty days for a third or subsequent					
18	violation."
