A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILD ABUSE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 350-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) Any individual who assumes a duty or responsibility
- 4 pursuant to section 350-2 or chapter 587 shall have immunity
- 5 from civil liability for acts or omissions performed in good
- 6 faith within the scope of the individual's duty or
- 7 responsibility. For purposes of this section, good faith shall
- 8 not include wilful misconduct, recklessness, or gross
- 9 negligence. Nothing in this section shall limit the liability
- 10 of the department, any other state agency, or any private
- 11 organization for the conduct of individuals provided immunity
- 12 herein."
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 14 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 15 begun, before its effective date.
- 16 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
