A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ALA WAI WATERSHED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that conservation land
- 2 trusts have been successful in providing a variety of public
- 3 benefits, such as the preservation of private land for public
- 4 use. The legislature further finds that the concept of a land
- 5 trust to assist in addressing the flooding, pollution, and
- 6 ecosystem degradation of the Ala Wai watershed should be
- 7 explored.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation for the
- 9 Ala Wai watershed.
- 10 SECTION 2. The department of land and natural resources
- 11 shall conduct a study, including solicitation of community
- 12 input, to evaluate the options, policy foundations, and
- 13 technical assessments on the use of land trusts to address the
- 14 flooding, pollution, and ecosystem degradation of the rivers and
- 15 streams within the Ala Wai watershed. The department of land
- 16 and natural resources shall report findings and recommendations
- 17 to the legislature not later than twenty days prior to the
- 18 convening of the regular session of 2009.

- 1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$150,000 or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for the
- 4 purposes of this Act.
- 5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 6 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
