A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to provide an exemption from chapter 343, Hawaii Revised Statutes, until 2 3 June 30, 2009, for proposed actions that only use state or 4 county highways and meet certain other limiting conditions. 5 SECTION 2. For the purpose of this Act, "action", 6 "environmental assessment", and "environmental impact statement" 7 or "statement" and "finding of no significant impact" mean the 8 same as defined in section 343-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes. 9 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding chapter 343, Hawaii Revised 10 Statutes, or any other law to the contrary, a proposed action 11 shall be exempt from the need for an environmental assessment, 12 finding of no significant impact, or an environmental impact 13 statement if the proposed action: Proposes the use, improvement, widening, excavation, 14 (1)15 or marking of a public highway that is on state or 16 county land or the placement of an easement through or

on a public highway that is on state or county land;

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1	(2)	Prop	ooses no other use or action listed under section
2		343-	5(a), Hawaii Revised Statutes, that would trigger
3		the	need for an environmental assessment; and
4	(3)	Complies with all of the following:	
5		(A)	The proposed action will not be undertaken on a
6			parcel of land of greater than acres;
7		(B)	The proposed action will not result in the
8			addition of more than square feet of
9			floor area within structures, as calculated under
10			the relevant county's zoning ordinance or
11			building code;
12		(C)	The proposed action will not result in an
13			increase of more than square feet of
14			building area, as calculated under the relevant
15			county's zoning ordinance or building code; and
16		(D)	The proposed action will not result in an
17			increase of more than persons to the
18			maximum permitted occupancy in all buildings
19			affected by the proposed action, as calculated
20			under the relevant county's building or fire
21			code.

- 1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval
- 2 and shall be repealed on June 30, 2009; provided that its repeal
- 3 shall not affect any proposed action exempted by this Act that
- 4 was begun prior to, but not yet completed by, the repeal date.
