A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC ACCESS TO COASTAL AREAS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 115, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§115- Public access to shorelines. Notwithstanding any
- 5 law to the contrary, the State shall provide public access to
- 6 the shoreline. To the extent practicable, the distance between
- 7 each access under this section shall not exceed one-quarter
- 8 mile."
- 9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$\\$ or so much
- 11 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for the
- 12 acquisition of public rights-of-way pursuant to section 1 of
- 13 this Act.
- 14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 15 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
- 16 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

- 2 provided that section 2 shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
