A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE HAWAII CONSTITUTION TO PROTECT THE TRADITIONAL CULTURAL PRACTICE OF FIGHTING GAMECOCKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
- 2 amendment to the Constitution of the State of Hawaii to
- 3 establish the right to engage in the traditional cultural
- 4 practice of fighting gamecocks.
- 5 SECTION 2. Article XII, section 7, of the Constitution of
- 6 the State of Hawaii is amended to read as follows:

7 "TRADITIONAL AND CUSTOMARY RIGHTS

- **8** Section 7. The State reaffirms and shall protect all
- 9 rights, customarily and traditionally exercised for subsistence,
- 10 cultural and religious purposes and possessed by ahupua'a
- 11 tenants who are descendants of native Hawaiians who inhabited
- 12 the Hawaiian Islands prior to 1778, subject to the right of the
- 13 State to regulate such rights. The right to engage in the
- 14 traditional cultural practice of fighting gamecocks shall not be
- 15 infringed."
- 16 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
- 17 be as follows:
