A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC PROCUREMENT CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 103D-305, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 Small purchases; prohibition against parceling. "§103D-305 4 (a) Procurement of less than \$50,000 for goods, services, or 5 construction, except as provided in subsection (c), shall be 6 made in accordance with procedures set forth in rules adopted by 7 the policy board that are designed to ensure administrative 8 simplicity and as much competition as is practicable; provided 9 that [multiple]: 10 (1) Multiple expenditures shall not be created at the 11 inception of a transaction or project so as to evade 12 the requirements of this chapter; and [provided 13 further that procurement] 14 Procurement requirements shall not be artificially (2) 15 divided or parceled so as to constitute a small 16 purchase under this section. 17 (b) Procurements of \$25,000 to less than \$50,000 shall be made in accordance with small purchase procedures; provided that 18

5	<u>(c)</u>	Procurements of less than \$50,000 for construction
6	drilling work and soil testing shall be made by competitive

9		be advertised to the public on the purchasing agency's
10		website; and
11	(2)	The bid for drilling and soil testing shall not be
12		combined with a bid for the engineering work on the
13		same project."
