RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 328J-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending the definition of "open to the public" to 3 read as follows: 4 ""Open to the public" means enclosed or partially enclosed 5 areas to which the public is invited or permitted and areas 6 within any building available for use by or accessible to the 7 general public during the normal course of business conducted 8 therein by either private or public entities, including but not 9 limited to bars, educational facilities, financial institutions, 10 health care facilities, hotel and motel lobbies, lanais, 11 laundromats, public transportation facilities, [including 12 airport areas from curb to cabin and including all areas within 13 and immediately in front of and adjacent to passenger terminals 14 and pick up areas, throughout] the interior of an airport 15 facility, [and] up to the passenger loading gates of all state 16 airports, reception areas, restaurants, retail food production 17 and marketing establishments, retail service establishments, 18 retail stores, shopping malls, sports arenas, theaters, and
