A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRIC GUNS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 134-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§134-16 Restriction on possession, sale, gift, or
- 4 delivery of electric guns. (a) [##] Except as otherwise
- 5 provided in subsection (c), it shall be unlawful for any person,
- 6 including a licensed manufacturer, licensed importer, or
- 7 licensed dealer, to possess, offer for sale, hold for sale,
- 8 sell, give, lend, or deliver any electric gun.
- 9 (b) Any electric gun in violation of subsection (a) shall
- 10 be confiscated and disposed of by the chief of police.
- 11 (c) This section shall not apply to law enforcement
- 12 officers [of county police and sheriff departments] of this
- 13 State[7] or vendors providing electric guns to those entities;
- 14 provided that electric guns shall at all times remain in the
- 15 custody and control of the county police [or sheriff
- 16 departments.], the departments of liquor control, and the
- 17 department of public safety.
