A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A GRADUATE MARITIME ARCHAEOLOGY AND HISTORY CERTIFICATE PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that from 1998 to 2003,
- 2 the University of Hawaii Marine Option Program successfully
- 3 administered the Graduate Maritime Archaeology and History
- 4 Program, drawing on faculty principally in Anthropology,
- 5 History, and American Studies at the University of Hawaii at
- 6 Manoa as well as professionals in government agencies,
- 7 consulting firms and non-governmental organizations. New
- 8 courses were introduced, research projects started and carried
- 9 forth with extramural moneys, and annual symposia have been held
- 10 to present day. The program was arbitrarily terminated by the
- 11 School of Ocean and Earth Science and Technology in 2003.
- 12 The legislature also finds that student interest in the
- 13 program continues, and faculty across the disciplines and
- 14 throughout the ten-campus University of Hawaii system are
- 15 motivated to reintroduce a Maritime Archaeology and History
- 16 program.

1 The legislature further finds that there are rich 2 materials, both locally and regionally, that if properly 3 developed, can form the basis of not only academic pursuits, but 4 also economic development through heritage tourism, allowing the 5 University of Hawaii to become the center of expertise in this 6 field for the Pacific. Accordingly, it is the purpose of this 7 Act to appropriate funds for a full-time faculty position at the 8 University of Hawaii at Manoa to head this program and to fund 9 clerical support. 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$100,000 or so much 11 12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for the 13 funding of a full-time faculty position at the University of 14 Hawaii at Manoa to serve as the head of the graduate maritime 15 archaeology and history certificate program, clerical support for the position, and partial funding of field schools. 16 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of 18 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act. SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008. 19 20 21
