A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that one of the barriers 2 to the development of housing affordable to the general 3 workforce is the regulatory process that exists in Hawaii. Duplication, fragmentation, and the lack of standards or 4 5 predictability are the cost-generating and supply-reducing consequences of Hawaii's regulatory process. 6 7 The purpose of this Act is to increase the supply of housing developments affordable to the general workforce by 8 9 providing an incentive to counties that streamline the 10 application process for building, construction, or development-11 related permits. 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 225M, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 13 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 14 and to read as follows:
- 15 "S225M- Incentive and streamlining grants program;
- 16 <u>incentive</u> and streamlining grants special fund; established.

- (d) The office of planning shall adopt rules pursuant to 3
- chapter 91 to effectuate the purposes of this section, including 4
- 5 the grant application process for the incentive and streamlining
- 6 grants program.
- 7 (e) Nothing in subsection (a) shall be construed to exempt
- 8 developments under this section from chapter 343 and other
- 9 environmental laws."
- 10 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$10,000,000 or so 11
- 12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for
- deposit into the incentive and streamlining grants special fund 13
- for the purposes of the incentive and streamlining grants 14
- 15 program.
- 16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of
- planning for the purposes of this Act. 17
- SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored. 18
- SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008. 19
