5	services. (a) Notwithstanding any provision of any individual
6	or group hospital or medical service plan contract, whenever the
7	contract of a mutual benefit society provides for payment for
8	any service performed by a participating provider of health care
9	services, the provider of the service shall be entitled to
10	payment at a rate of not less than one hundred and twenty per
11	cent of the national average cost of the service, as determined
12	by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor
13	Statistics. The rate shall be adjusted no later than fourteen
14	days after the Bureau of Labor Statistics releases such data to
15	the public.
16	(b) The department of commerce and consumer affairs shall

adopt rules under chapter 91 as necessary for the purposes of
