A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ISLAND OF NI'IHAU

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the island of Niihau
- 2 occupies a vulnerable position in the Hawaiian island chain. As
- 3 the last bastion of native Hawaiian fishers, Hawaiian cultural
- 4 practitioners, and native speakers of the Hawaiian language,
- 5 Niihau stands to lose much if it is not properly protected.
- 6 The legislature further finds that the public shore access
- 7 and domain on Niihau up to the vegetation mark exacerbates
- 8 Niihau's vulnerability. Recreational beachgoers and fishers
- ${f 9}$ abuse the right to access Niihau's precious shores, often
- 10 leaving behind their debris, fishing gear, and, at times, even
- 11 their personal excrement. These senseless infractions have
- 12 caused Niihau's residents to worry about their onshore and
- 13 offshore resources, and many residents feel unsafe because they
- 14 maintain an open-door policy.
- 15 The purpose of this Act is to designate the waters
- 16 surrounding the island of Niihau as a marine life conservation
- 17 district.

1	SECT	ION 2. The waters surrounding the island of Niihau, as
2	defined in	the administrative rules of the department of land
3	and natura	al resources, shall be designated a marine life
4	conservati	ion district, as provided in chapter 190, Hawaii
5	Revised St	tatutes. The department of land and natural resources,
6	in consult	tation with the 'aha kiole advisory committee, and when
7	establishe	ed, the 'aha moku council, shall adopt exceptions to the
8	conservati	on district and other rules and prohibitions
9	consistent	with sections 190-3 and 190-4, Hawaii Revised
10	Statutes;	provided that the department of land and natural
11	resources	shall at a minimum adopt rules permitting the
12	following	activities:
13	(1)	Residents of the island of Niihau may take and possess
14		enough limu kohu and limu lipe'epe'e, for subsistence
15	9	(combined total, squeezed dry) by hand harvest only;
16		provided that the limu holdfast is left in place;
17	(2)	Residents of the island of Niihau may take and possess
18		any finfish with hook-and-line from the shoreline;
19		provided that each person may use not more than two
20		poles; provided further that each pole may have no
21		more than one line; provided further that each line

may have no more than two hooks; and

1	(3)	To take with legal nets and possess 'opelu during
2		August and September, and akule during the appropriate
3		season.

4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
