A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ISLAND OF NI'IHAU

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the island of Ni'ihau
- 2 occupies a vulnerable position in the Hawaiian island chain and
- 3 is a sanctuary where the residents are able to live and practice
- 4 their native Hawaiian culture and speak their native Hawaiian
- 5 language. Much of Ni'ihau's environment remains pristine and
- 6 scenic.
- 7 Recreational beachgoers and fishers abuse the right to
- 8 access Ni'ihau's precious shores, often leaving behind their
- 9 fishing gear, opala, and other debris. Ni'ihau is an island
- 10 with both cultural and natural treasures that must be protected.
- 11 Effective and prudent management from Ni'ihau's land-based,
- 12 shoreline, and marine resources must be in place while allowing
- 13 the residents to continue their cultural practices.
- 14 The purpose of this Act is to institute a conservation
- 15 ethic and cultural use of Ni'ihau's precious resources by
- 16 designating the waters surrounding the island of Ni'ihau as a
- 17 marine life conservation district.



<u>.</u>	SECTION 2. The waters surrounding the island of Nilhau, a	
2	defined i	n the administrative rules of the department of land
3	and natural resources, shall be designated a marine life	
4	conservation district, pursuant to chapter 190, Hawaii Revised	
5	Statutes.	The department of land and natural resources, in
6	consultation with the 'aha kiole advisory committee, and when	
7	establish	ed, the 'aha moku council, shall adopt rules that:
8	(1)	Restrict all forms of thrill craft, including jet
9		skis, and tour boat activities in the marine life
10		conservation district;
11	(2)	Permit all current forms of fishing as provided by
12		statute within the marine life conservation district;
13		and
14	(3)	Permit, restrict, or condition other activities,
15		including allowing exceptions to the conservation
16		district and other rules and prohibitions consistent
17		with sections 190-3 and 190-4, Hawaii Revised
18		Statutes.
19	SECT	ION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
