## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEDICAID.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- The legislature finds that provider 1 SECTION 1. reimbursements under the federal Medicare and Medicaid Programs 2 do not adequately compensate physicians for their services and 3 are contributing to the health care crisis in Hawaii. 4 where medicare reimbursements are set by the Federal Government, 5 Hawaii has the ability to increase reimbursements under 6 7 medicaid. 8 The purpose of this Act is to provide fairer levels of compensation for individual practitioners who participate in the 9 medicaid program, by increasing the rates of reimbursement under 10 the Hawaii medicaid fee schedule. 11 SECTION 1. Section 346-59, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 12 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 13 Rates of payment to providers of medical care who are 14 "(b) individual practitioners, including doctors of medicine, 15 dentists, podiatrists, psychologists, osteopaths, optometrists, 16
- 17 and other individuals providing services, shall be based upon
- 18 the Hawaii medicaid fee schedule. The amounts paid shall not HB HMS 2007-1068



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- 1 exceed the maximum permitted to be paid individual practitioners
- 2 or other individuals under federal law and regulation, the
- 3 medicare fee schedule for the current year, the state limits as
- 4 provided in the appropriation act, or the provider's billed
- 5 amount.
- 6 The appropriation act shall indicate the percentage of the
- 7 medicare fee schedule for the year [2000] 2006 to be used as the
- 8 basis for establishing the Hawaii medicaid fee schedule. For
- 9 any subsequent adjustments to the fee schedule, the legislature
- 10 shall specify the extent of the adjustment in the appropriation
- 11 act."
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 and the
- 15 sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for
- 16 fiscal year 2008-2009 to increase the medicaid fee schedule to
- 17 per cent of the 2006 medicare fee schedule.
- 18 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 19 of human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 21 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
