## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 291C-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§291C-13 Accidents involving damage to vehicle or property. (a) The driver of any vehicle involved in an 4 accident resulting only in damage to a vehicle or other property 5 that is driven or attended by any person shall immediately stop 7 such vehicle [at the scene of the accident or as close thereto 8 as possible, after removing the vehicle to a safe location off 9 of the roadway, including a shoulder lane or median, as close to the scene of the accident as possible but shall forthwith return 10
- 11 to, and in every event shall remain at, the scene of the
- 12 accident until the driver has fulfilled the requirements of
- 13 section 291C-14. Every such stop shall be made without
- 14 obstructing traffic more than is necessary.
- 15 (b) The driver or attendant of any vehicle involved in an
- 16 accident who has removed the vehicle from the scene of the
- 17 accident in accordance with subsection (a) before the arrival of
- 18 a police officer shall not be considered liable or at fault



- 1 regarding the cause of the accident solely by reason of moving
- 2 the vehicle."
