

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-12, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) Every person who has reached the age of eighteen
4 years or who is [~~seventeen~~] sixteen years of age and will be
5 eighteen years of age by the date of the next election, and is
6 otherwise qualified to register may do so for that election.
7 The person shall then be listed upon the appropriate county
8 general register and precinct list. No person shall register or
9 vote in any other precinct than that in which the person resides
10 except as provided in section 11-21."

11 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
