RELATING TO THE PROCUREMENT CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: "§103D- Hawaii agricultural products. (a) To encourage 4 the purchase and use of Hawaii agricultural products in the food 5
- 6 operations of state correctional facilities, state hospitals and
- healthcare facilities, and public schools, contracts shall be 7
- 8 awarded to the lowest responsible and responsive bidders, with
- 9 preference given to the agricultural products raised or grown in
- 10 Hawaii.
- 11 The policy board shall adopt rules in accordance with
- 12 chapter 91 governing preference for Hawaii agricultural
- products. The rules shall establish percentages of preference 13
- 14 and the method of determining the qualifications of various
- agricultural products for preference. 15
- 16 The state procurement office, with the assistance of
