
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
THIRTY-EIGHTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Mililani's thirty-eighth representative
2 district encompasses the new and expanding area of Mililani
3 Mauka and the oldest part of the town, including the town
4 center.

5 The original Mililani schools are nearly forty years old.
6 Many of the facilities at these schools are outdated and in need
7 of restoration and electrical upgrades to systems that may be as
8 rudimentary as a bell system and as complex as updating the
9 school's entire electrical system. To address traffic
10 congestion and safety problems at these schools, funds are
11 provided for a drop-off and pick-up turnaround, improvements to
12 driveways, and expansion of school parking lots to move cars on
13 and off the roadways as smoothly and efficiently as possible.
14 Funds are also provided for a guest parking lot to accommodate
15 the added usage that will come with the ten-classroom building
16 being constructed at Mililani high school. The need for more
17 space is a recurring need in this growing community, which



1 prompted funding of innovative solutions such as pod-type
2 classrooms for the Mililani Waena elementary school.

3 Since the Mililani Mauka area also experiences heavy
4 rainfall, there is a need for covered play courts and covered
5 bus stops to address the health and safety needs of students.

6 SECTION 2. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
7 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
8 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
9 Hawaii for fiscal year 2007-2008.

10 1. To be expended by the department of education:

11 A. Mililani high school, Oahu

12 Design and construction for a drop off, turnaround,
13 and guest parking area for the new ten-classroom
14 building.
