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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR SPORTS FACILITY.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the erstwhile motor  
2 sports facility in leeward Oahu allowed motor vehicles to  
3 compete in motor sports under safe conditions and provided a  
4 vital service to the community by keeping motor racing and all  
5 of its inherent dangers off the public streets and freeways. A  
6 motor sports facility can also be a benefit to public safety by  
7 providing a place to safely train law enforcement personnel from  
8 the State and the counties, as well as the general public, in  
9 the safe handling of motor vehicles.

10           The purpose of this Act is to determine the cost of  
11 developing and operating a new motor sports facility in the  
12 State.

13           SECTION 2. (a) The department of accounting and general  
14 services shall conduct a study to determine the cost of  
15 developing an all-purpose motor sports facility in the State,  
16 including acquisition of land, construction, and cost of start-  
17 up, maintenance, and operation.



1 (b) The department shall consider at least the following  
2 cost factors:

3 (1) Acquisition of adequate land by purchase, lease,  
4 exchange, or any other appropriate means, including  
5 financing;

6 (2) Planning, design, and construction of the facility,  
7 including:

8 (A) Multi-purpose driving surfaces, barriers,  
9 fencing, lighting, and driver communication  
10 systems;

11 (B) Training and educational facilities, including  
12 classrooms;

13 (C) Safety and first response medical facility and  
14 safety containment systems;

15 (D) Participant and spectator accommodations,  
16 including maintenance, security, storage, and  
17 other supporting facilities; and

18 (E) Equipment intended for permanent use in the  
19 facility.

20 (3) Initial costs of start-up, if any;

21 (4) Routine maintenance of the facility for the first ten  
22 years; and



1 (5) Routine operating costs, taking into account any fees  
2 that may be charged to users of the facility.

3 (c) The department shall submit a written final report to  
4 the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening  
5 of the regular session of 2008.

6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
