
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSIENT ACCOMMODATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3 read as follows:

4 "§46- Construction of transient accommodations. Within
5 twelve months of the effective date of this Act, each county
6 shall adopt ordinances requiring that the development,
7 redevelopment, renovation, or modification of any structure
8 containing transient accommodations, as defined in section
9 237D-2, shall be developed, redeveloped, renovated, or modified
10 in accordance with the latest edition of the International
11 Building Code, as published by the International Code Council;
12 provided that the effective date of the ordinance may be six
13 months from the adoption of the ordinance."

14 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
