BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, to 13
- establish a twenty-four-hour, seven-days-a-week, rapid response 14
- 15 emergency medical services unit to serve the Mililani/Mililani
- 16 Mauka area on Oahu.
