
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
2 to establish a twenty-four-hour, seven-days-a-week, rapid
3 response emergency medical services unit for the
4 Mililani/Mililani Mauka area on Oahu, to include personnel,
5 equipment, and operational expenses.

6 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,500,000 for fiscal
8 year 2007-2008 to be deposited into the emergency medical
9 services special fund.

10 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the emergency
11 medical services special fund the sum of \$1,500,000 or so much
12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 to
13 establish a twenty-four-hour, seven-days-a-week, rapid response
14 emergency medical services unit to serve the Mililani/Mililani
15 Mauka area on Oahu.

16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
17 health for the purposes of this Act.

18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
