
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§304A- Classroom instruction; earliest start.
5 Beginning on the first day of instruction of the fall semester
6 of 2007, for the purpose of reducing traffic congestion on Oahu,
7 no classroom instruction at the University of Hawaii-Manoa
8 campus shall begin earlier than 9 a.m. during weekdays."

9 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on August 20, 2007.
